


# Fall 2022 Enrollment Update IUPUI Faculty Council

### **Overall enrollment**

#### Student Enrollment IUPUI, IUPUC and IUFW



#### **Total enrollment**

- 25,979 (24,141 Indianapolis), -6.2% from Fall 2021
  - Follows 5.8% drop from Fall 2020 to Fall 2021
  - 15,966 undergraduates in Indianapolis (-7.8% from Fall 2021)
  - 5,245 graduate students in Indianapolis (-3.2% from Fall 2021)
  - 2,930 professional students (-1.7% from Fall 2021
- 326,341 credit hours (302,466 in Indianapolis), -5.3% from Fall 2021
  - Follows 6.4% from Fall 2020 to Fall 2021





## **Total enrollment Good News**

- 8,384 students of color (7,971 in Indianapolis)
  - Almost 1/3 of IUPUI students (32.3%, 33.0% of Indianapolis students)
  - Record high Asian American students (1,897)
- 1,751 International (1,726 Indianapolis),
  +15.2%
- 21,803 Indiana residents (22,806 at IU Bloomington; 20,028 Indianapolis only)
- 4,176 non-resident students (record high)





## Indianapolis New Beginners by last attended 2013-2022




## Enrolled Test Optional IUPUI IN Beginning Students (3,147 Total Beginners Fall 2022)

- >1,789 (56.8%) New Beginners applied Test Optional in Fall 2022.
  - 980 (55.0%) Test Optional Students were University College Admits
  - 809 (47.4%) Test Optional Students were Directly Admitted to a Degree Granting School
- >809 (47.5%) out of 1,705 Direct Admit Students were Test Optional
- ➤ 980 (68.0%) out of 1,442 University College students were Test Optional




