



Our current process

- Collected feedback from faculty and staff to previous questions
- Add current Peers, urban 13, Carnegie, other suggested institutions
- Collected IPEDS data
 - Percent FTFT on campus, Percent FTT Pell, SAT 75th percentile (ACT converted), FTFT retention, Percent African American, Percent Latinx, Six year graduation, Six year drop, Total headcount, Percent Undergrad, Four year Graduation rate, Pell graduation rate, Carnegie classification (dummy code same as IUPUI), Number of degrees conferred, degrees offered
- Cluster analysis
