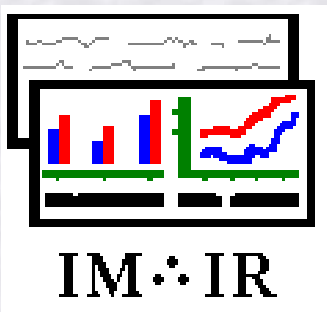

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Highlights of the Alumni Survey for 1995-96 Undergraduate Degree

Recipients

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Highlights

[Current Employment.](#) The vast majority of recent alumni are employed (93%). Four percent are not seeking work and less than one percent are in the military. Two percent are unemployed. Four out of ten continue to work for employers they worked for prior to graduating. Among those with new jobs, two-thirds attained jobs that require a college degree. Over eighty percent of recent alumni say their job is related to their major and ninety-five percent say their IUPUI education enhanced their future prospects. The overall median salary for 1995-96 undergraduate degree recipients is \$25,000 to \$30,000.

[Further Education.](#) Nearly eight in ten recent alumni intend to further their education: one fourth are currently enrolled and half are planning to enroll at some institution of higher education in the future. More than half (54%) of those currently furthering their education are doing so at IUPUI. Considering all alumni who received their undergraduate degree during the 1995-96 academic year, one in ten are currently enrolled at IUPUI and another one-half say it is likely they will further their education here. In all, seven of ten recent alumni either are currently attending or plan to further their education at IUPUI.

[Impact of IUPUI on Alumni Learning.](#) In the Spring 1996 survey new items were introduced to measure the Nine Principles of Undergraduate Learning. These measures examine alumni growth in each of the nine areas in addition to alumni perceptions about whether the proper emphasis was placed on each area. Results this year (Spring 1997 survey) continue to indicate the most growth occurred in the areas of intellectual depth and critical thinking. Again this year the majority of alumni feel that too little emphasis is placed on developing computer skills.

[Satisfaction with IUPUI Experience.](#) Alumni are most satisfied with what they consider to be the most important aspects of their experience here. The quality of education received at IUPUI and the quality of teaching by faculty in their major area rank highest in terms of both importance and satisfaction followed by courses in the major. Recent alumni are least satisfied with their opportunities to work on faculty research projects, engage in extra-curricular activities, and engage in community service, each of which ranks comparatively low in terms of importance. Academic advising is an important concern for most alumni, but ranks relatively low in terms of satisfaction.

Changes From Previous Year ([Link to last year's report](#))

Satisfaction. Substantive increases (statistically significant mean differences of $> .20$ on a 5 point scale) occurred in six areas of alumni satisfaction this year compared to last. The largest increase occurred in the area of required courses outside the major, opportunities to engage in faculty members' research, the quality of teaching by other faculty (not in the major), courses in the major,

academic advising in the major - a high importance area, and opportunities to engage in extra-curricular activities. Moderately large and statistically significant ($p > .01$) increases were also observed in the areas of opportunities to engage in community services, helpfulness of staff, opportunities to increase self-understanding, opportunities to integrate learning with personal experiences and the overall quality of the education received at IUPUI - the area where students expressed the greatest level of satisfaction this year and last.

Other. The only other notable changes over last year occurred in the areas of employment and further education. This year's alumni were less likely than those in the prior year to indicate they had worked for their current employer continuously prior to receiving their degree (47% vs. 38%). A continuing good job market may be allowing graduates the option to consider new employers to further their careers or to change careers altogether.

Last year saw a large drop in the percent of alumni (baccalaureates) furthering their education doing so at IUPUI (64% vs. 46%). This year those percentages recovered somewhat as 54% of those continuing their education chose to do so at IUPUI.

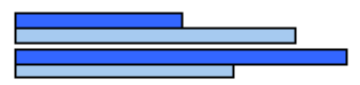

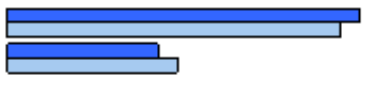

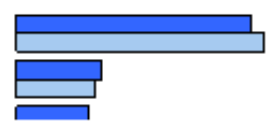

How Closely Does Current Job Relate to Major

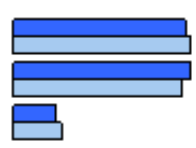

How Well IUPUI Education Prepared Alumni for Current Job

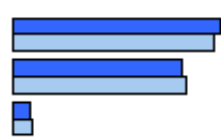

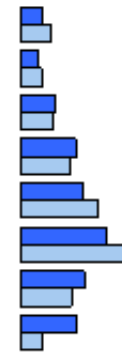
How Well IUPUI Education Has Enhanced Future Prospects

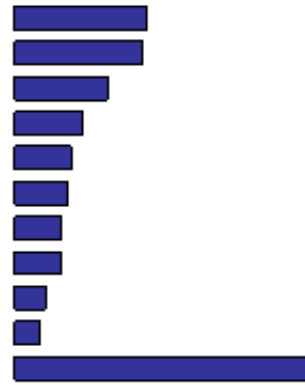

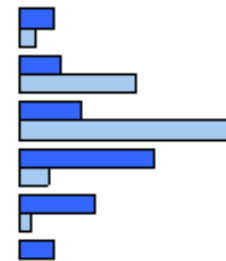

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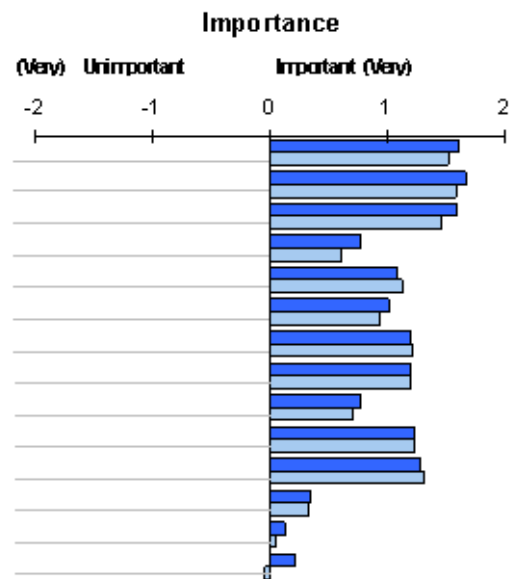

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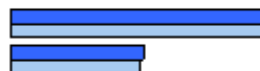
