2011 UNDERGRADUATE ALUMNI STUDENT SURVEY

Results for Respondents 25 Years of Age or Older

The IUPUI Alumni Survey began in 1992, with a new revised version first administered in 2011. The Alumni Survey has 4 sections focusing on graduates' satisfaction with their overall IUPUI experience, the impact of IUPUI on their learning, further education, and current employment. This report summarizes responses of students who received bachelor's degrees between Spring 2008 and Summer 2010 and were 25 years of age or older (n = 246) by their graduation date. A total of 511 alumni responded to the survey for an overall response rate of 10.5%.
