Key Highlights/Findings

- Students were most excited about "meeting new people/making new friends" (32%).
- The students were also excited to be "learning in their classes" (e.g. learning new things, learning about major, learn new skills, hands on experience) (9%).
- The number one concern the students reported was "getting good grades in their class" (18%).
- Students were also concerned about their "time management skills" (12%).

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Mentor Intake Form Qualitative Report

Introduction

The Mentor Intake Form is administered to all new beginning students enrolled in First-Year Seminar courses before they meet with a student mentor. The student mentors send the Qualtrics survey link to each student before they have an individual meeting. Survey completion is not required but it is highly encouraged as it helps the mentors understand students' needs. During the Fall 2016 semester, 2,062 students responded to the Mentor Intake Form. Some students provided more than one comment for each question. The total number of comments for each question is indicated at the top of each table and does not directly correspond to the number of students responding.

Included on the form were two open ended questions: "What are you most excited about at IUPUI this semester?" and "What are you most concerned about this semester?" The answers to these questions were then entered into ATLAS.ti comment coding software. The comments were coded to discern what major themes emerged. These themes and corresponding actual student comments are displayed in Tables 1 and 2.
